We feel her horror as we understand with her what is about to happen. The scene then moves on to another, equally heartbreaking moment, three days later, when a neighbor's dog finds a body part. You think at this point that you wouldn't be able to read any further that you would close the book and never open it. But you can't. Like Susie, we want to know that her family is going to be okay. We want to know that the killer is not going to die. The author, Alice Sebold, artfully makes you read on. Susie watches her friends whisper about her at school. She watches her younger sister Lindsay harden to the point. Her four-year-old brother, Buckley, passed from neighbour to neighbor while spending the night, said his sister had just left for a while. She listens to Detective Len, tells her parents the inevitable that they are now investigating her disappearance as a murder. Her family slowly begins to crumble and Susie can do nothing to help. It sounds like a suffocating, depressing book, but as you read you'll feel encouraged as Susie's family starts moving on, never forgetting, but to start living without her. Buckley struggles to understand the meaning forever. Susie's father becomes obsessed with proof that he is not crazy, that he is sure who killed his daughter. Susie's mom copes with stress by hiding from it. And Lindsay, known as the girl whose sister was killed, seeks to find herself again. She's looking for love. And she takes a huge risk to help her father get rid of the killer. The ending is incredibly sweet. It's amazing how you might feel you'll feel Susie's joy as she those she left behind. For me, the ending wasn't perfect, it's this I wish, but I think that was intentional. Life itself is not perfect. But life has hope. And that's the feeling that will stay with you as you turn the last page. It's a memorable reading, not for the faint of heart. Expect to feel. Afraid, crying and, yes, laughing. Lovely Bones is a deplorable movie with this message: If you're a 14-year-old girl who was brutally raped and murdered by a serial killer, you have a lot to look forward to. You can gather in heaven with others teens of the same killer, and look down in benevolence at your family members as they they you and understand what a wonderful person you were. Sure, you miss your friends, but your doom mates come dancing to greet you in a meadow of wildflowers, and how great is it? The filmmakers seem to have given a little thought about the psychology of teenage girls, less to the possibility that there is no sky, and no one at all has the chance that if there is one, it will not resemble a happy gathering of new Facebook friends. In his version of events, the serial killer can almost be seen as a hero for freeing these girls from the tedious ordeal of growing up and sending them directly to the Champs-Elysees. The main effect of the film was to make me squirm. It's based on Alice Sebold's bestseller that everyone seemed to be reading a couple of years ago. I hope this is not true to the book; if so, millions of Americans are scared. Killing a young man is a tragedy, a monster killer, and make the victim a sweet, poetic storyteller spooky. This film sells a philosophy that even the evil of God's will, and their victims are happier now. Isn't it nice to think that. I think it's better if they don't happen at all. But if they're doing it, why pretend they're not in pain? These girls are dead. I am sure, however, that Sebold's novel is well written and sensitive. I suppose the director, Peter Jackson, has distorted elements to fit his own vision, which includes almost as many special effects in some sequences as his Lord of the Rings trilogy. A more useful way of dealing with this material would be with observational, subtle speeches in a thoughtful scenario. It's not a good story. Perhaps Jackson's team made the mistake of fearing that the affair was too dark. But its millions of readers need to know that this is not the case. The target audience may be doomed teenage girls - the Twilight crowd. The owner of the lovely bones is called Susie Salmon (Saoirse Ronan, a very good young actress who can't be charged here). Heaven Susie takes looks a bit like the flower power of the world in the form of a fantasy that, killed in 1973, she could imagine. It seems to me that paradise, by definition, is

free of time and space, will have neither flowers nor lack of flowers - there will be a state without sensations. Wouldn't be thinking there, let alone narrating. In eternity, spent in the presence of infinite kindness, you do not go around thinking: Man! That's great! You're just. I have a lot of theologians on my side here. But no. From her film set valhalla, Susie looks down as her mother (Rachel Weisz) grieves and her father (Mark Wahlberg) tries to solve the case himself. There's not much to deal with; we know who the killer is almost in the morning, and, according to the law of economy characters, who he should be, because (a) he played an otherwise unnecessary movie star, and (b) there is no one in the movie it can be. That's something bittersweet. Weiss and Wahlberg Like parents. Because the pyrotechnics are mostly upstairs with special effects, all they need to be is convincing parents who have lost their daughter. They do it with touching subtlety. We also meet one of Susie's grandmothers (Susan Sarandon), an unwise drinker who comes to provide a hard-boiled comic relief, in Shakespeare's tradition that every tragedy needs its own clown. Well, she's good, too. This whole movie is Jackson's fault. It won't let you down simply because I suspect his message. It fails on its own terms. It is not emotionally convincing that this girl, having these experiences and destined to be 14 forever (albeit cleaned and with a new wardrobe), will produce this celestial being. What are we left to regret? We should all end up like her, and the sooner the better; preferably not after rape and murder.
