These updates and clarifications will overshadow the materials contained in this document. 1. Where the Owner's Guide uses the terms of a service center, service center, your service center, a maintenance specialist or service, we wanted to clarify that these terms refer to the BMW dealer's service center or another service center or repair shop, which employs trained personnel who can repair and repair your car in accordance with BMW specifications. 2. Where the text of the Owner's Guide contains the affirmative instructions to contact the service center or your service center, we would like to clarify that THE BMW recom-repair that if you encounter one of the situations dealt with by this text, you con-tact or seek help from the service a BMW dealer or other service center or repair shop that uses trained personnel who can perform repairs on your car. While BMW BMW America LLC, on a free basis for you, will pay for the repairs required by the limited warranty provided for your vehicle and for maintenance under the maintenance program during the appli-cable warranty and maintenance periods of coverage, you can choose, both during these periods and after that, to have the basic-tenance and repair work provided by other service centers or repair workshops. 3. Where the Owner's Guide refers to parts and accessories approved by BMW, these references are intended to reflect that these details and accessories are recommended by BMW of North America LLC. You can use other parts and accessories, but if you do, we recommend that you make sure that any such parts and/or accessories are assigned eaten for use on your car. 4. On page 7, according to the warranty section of dis-cussion homologation, where it states that you cannot file warranty requirements for your car there, the text should read that you may not be able to file warranty requirements for your car there. 5. On page 7, in the Part and accesso-ries section, the sixth sentence says the word can't read. 6. On page 54 in the check and replace seatbelts text begins: This should only be done by your service center ... should be ignored, and the following text should be read instead: BMW recommends that this work behind the formed service center as important as it is that this safety function functions function properly. 7. On page 91, under the headline: Special windshield, point of origin, therefore, have a special windshield ... Should be ignored and the following text should be read instead: BMW recommends that you have a special windshield replaced by a service center. 8. On page 158 under the headline: Objects within the ped-as range and on page 207 under the headline: Carpets and floor mats, the item that begins: Only use mats ... Be ignored and the following language should be read instead: Your car's Manu-facter recommends you use floor mats that they have identified as suitable for use in your car, and which can be properly corrected on the spot. 9. On page 164 under the headline: Maintenance is carried out, a proposal begins: Maintenance must be carried out ... should be ignored and the following text should be read instead of the online edition for part 01 40 2 960 759 - II/15 Page 6 of the 226Addendum of them: BMW recommends that you have the service carried out by your service center. 10. On page 172, headlined Tire infla-tion specification, the proposal starts-ning, Tire inflation pressure specifications apply to approved tire sizes... should be ignored. 11. On 176, under the headline: Mountain-ing, point start, have montage and balancing ... should be dis-considered and the next text should be read in of these: BMW recommends that you have the installation and balancing behind being formed by your service center or tire mounting specialist. 12. On page 176, the term approved wheels and tires should be ignored under the heading Approved Wheels and Tires, and the term recommended should be searched instead. In addition, the text of this sec-tion should be ignored and the subsequent ING text should be read instead: The manufacturer of your car is strongly advised to use the wheels and tires that have been recommended by the vehicle manufacturer for your type of vehicle; other wise, for example, despite the same official size ratings, changes can lead to contact with the body and with it, the risk of serious accidents. The manufacturer of your car does not evaluate unspecified wheels and tires to determine whether they are suitable for use on your car. 13. On page 180, under the headline: Snow chains, the text should be ignored, and the following text should be read instead: Only certain types of fine-connected snow chains have been tested by your car manufacturer and identified by your car manufacturer to be safe for traffic and recommended by your car manufacturer. Information about the recommended snow chains is available at the service center. 14. On page 181, the headline Hood should ignore the sentence that begins: If you're unfamiliar. 15. On page 185, under the headline: Changing engine oil, the text should be ignored and should instead read as follows: BMW recommends that you have the oil changed in the service of your dealer BMW cen-ter or in another service center, which has prepared staff who can perform the work according to BMW specifications. 16 years old. On page 188, under the headline: Service and Guarantee Information Booklet for U.S. Models and Guarantee and Maintenance Guide Booklet for Canadian Models, the second paragraph should be ignored and the following text read instead: Manufacturer of your car recom-repair that you have maintenance and repairs carried out by your BMW dealer's sulfur-vice center or other service center or repair shop that uses trained personnel who can perform maintenance and maintenance according to BMW. On page 196, under the headline Use Only Approved Chargers, the offer to use only approved chargers begins... you should ignore and read the following text instead: BMW recommends using only approved chargers. You can get information about approved chargers at your service center.
